



Bunny codes

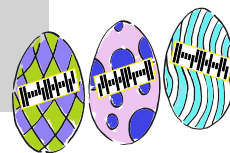


The Easter Bunny's Post Office uses postal codes that contain four characters. To make the postal codes readable by the Egg Scanner, they convert the postal codes into Bunny codes. In a Bunny code, each character is represented by 4 vertical bars that have an upper section and a lower section. When the upper section and lower section are put together, that represents a character. The table shows the codes for several characters.
