

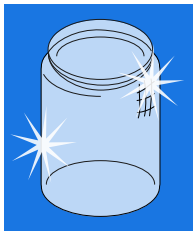


Grandmother's jam

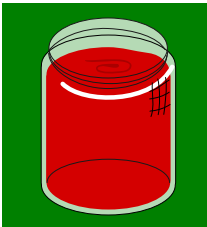


Anna, Peter, and Lisa help their grandmother to make cranberry jam for Christmas.

In order to make a jar of jam, they have to do three jobs (see below). At any time, any child can do any job.



Wash a jar. This takes 3 minutes.



Fill the washed jar with jam. This takes 2 minutes.



Close and decorate the filled jar. This takes 1 minute.
