




Trick-or-treat bags



The Trick-or-Treaters are coming soon but we have no sweets! It's time to go to the shop. The shop gives tricky instructions on how to purchase sweets. This is shown in the diagram:



Three different coloured bags of sweets can be bought (purple, black or orange). The numbers indicate how many of each bag must be added with each purchase. Each bag is used for the two treats below it. The numbers above the treats indicate how many treats must be added in each bag. For example, there must be zero or one black bags with each purchase, and each black bag must have one or two jelly packets and must have one, two or three bars of chocolate.
