

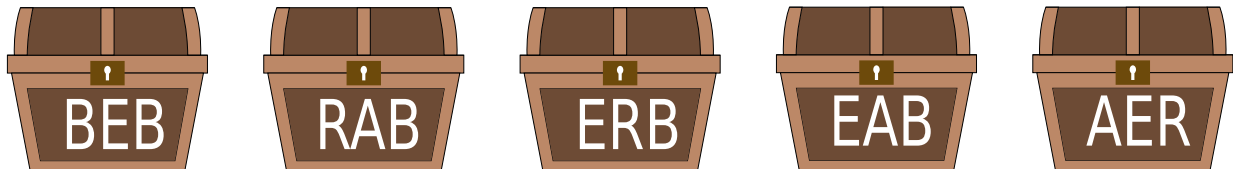


Locked chests



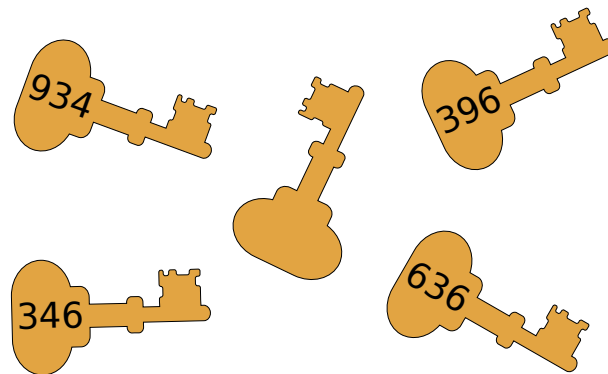
Jacques is a porter in an apartment building. There are five apartments. Each apartment is occupied by one owner. Leaving for work, the owners give their keys to Jacques.

To not mix up the keys Jacques uses a chests to store the key for each apartment. There are the first three letters of the owner's name on each chest.



For security reasons, no names are written on the keys. Instead Jacques put three digit labels on the keys to indicate the owner. For all the keys the same letter always corresponds to the same single digit.

Today, all the keys fell on the floor. One of the labels got lost.
