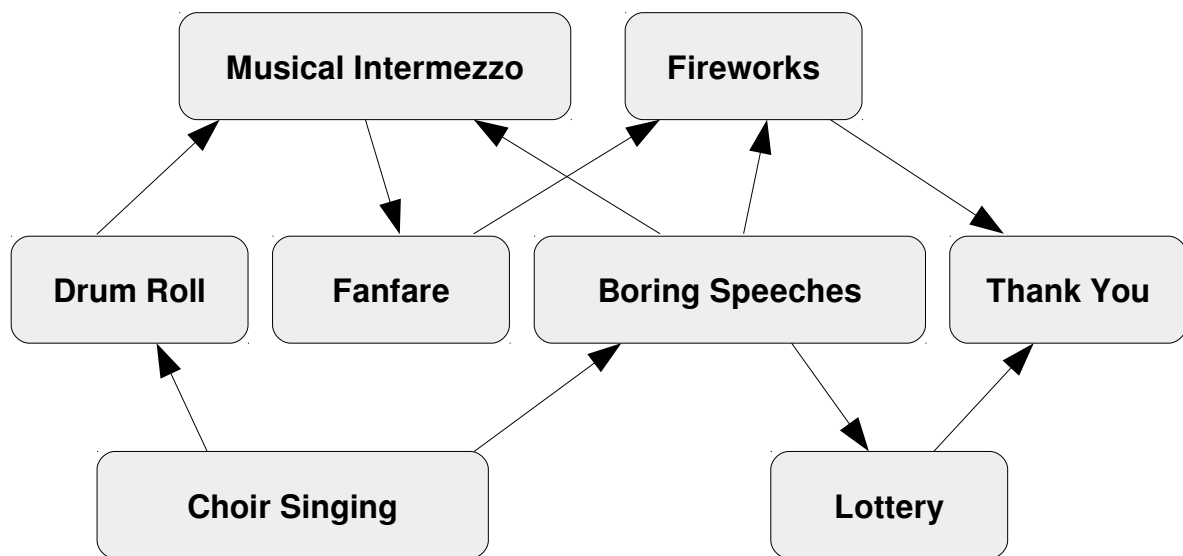




Graduation
